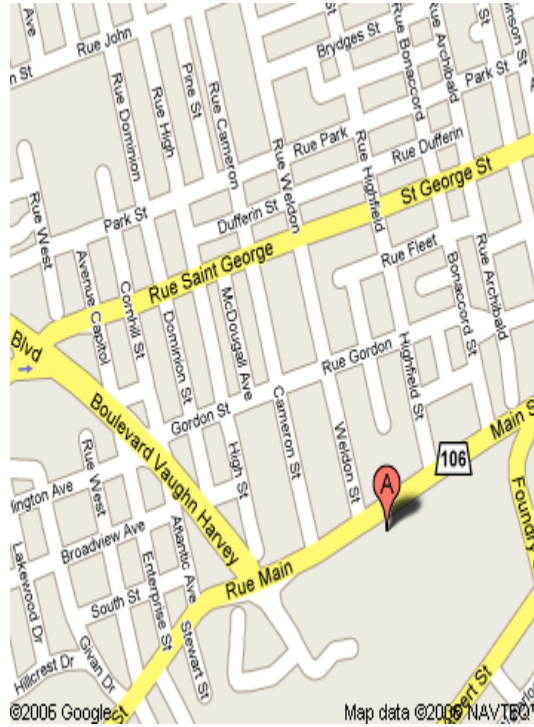

The Moncton Art Society invites you to participate in our 22st Provincial Art Fair and Sale from April 29 - May 6, 2007 to be held at Highfield Square. 1100 Main Street, Moncton, New Brunswick

Our goal is to promote visual arts of professional and emerging New Brunswick artists, to offer the public an exhibition in a professional manner, and to provide the public opportunity to purchase original works of art.

This year, Shirley Hallee, BA, MA (Fine Arts) of Amherst, Nova Scotia, has been selected as judge for this exhibition. Ms Hallee brings a wealth of expertise and experience to this position. All participating artists will be limited to displaying two (2) original works of art.

The Moncton Art Society welcomes the participation of all artists and appreciates your collaboration in this worthwhile project celebrating art in our province. We look forward to meeting you and viewing your works.

1. Each work submitted must be an original piece created by the participating artist and not copied in whole or in part from another artist's work or from any published newspaper, magazine, book, card, or digital image not owned by the participating artist.
2. A maximum of two (2) works may be submitted. Together, the size of the submitted works including frames must not exceed 15 square feet. Sculptural work may be wall pieces or free standing. (Please bring your own base to display your work).
3. Each art piece must be available for sale The Moncton Art Society Inc. will retain 20 % sales commission deducted from the listed price of any work sold.
4. An entry fee of \$20.00 per artist must accompany each entry form - please print clearly, sign, clip the form and mail with payment to the address on the form, to be postmarked no later than April 2, 2007. No changes or additions can be accepted after this date as the Provincial Art Fair Catalogue will be in production.
5. Please indicate on the entry form if you plan to:
  - enter your work for judging
  - attend the opening (Sunday, April 29, 2007 at 2:00 p.m.)
  - purchase an advertisement in the Fair Catalogue (please enclose \$25.00 per ad and a business card)
6. Each piece must arrive framed and ready for hanging with all appropriate hardware securely attached at the back, identified on the back with the artist's name, address, telephone number, and showing the title, medium, and list price of the work. Sculptural works must have similar identification.
7. All work must be on location no later than 12:00 noon, Saturday, April 28, 2007. No changes different from the entry form can be made. The artist assumes all costs, responsibilities and risks for art works in transit to and from the show. Works are hung and displayed at the artist's own risk during the event The Provincial Art Fair Committee or its agent(s) are responsible for hanging work of art for the exhibition.
8. All unsold work is to be picked up and removed from the location between 4:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. on Sunday, May 6, 2007.
9. The Moncton Art Society, or its agents, cannot be held liable for loss or damage to any work of art.
